




Arizona Chapter FBI National Academy Associates Presents

The schedule is full and engaging; running from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. each day because growth happens when you're active, involved, and challenged.

All activities are supervised by trusted mentors who are graduates of, or affiliated with, the FBI National Academy and are fully background checked and vetted. The staff-to-student ratio is approximately 1 mentor for every 6 students, ensuring a supportive and personal experience.
